PLAN YOUR TRIP

WALKING ROUTE

The walk from Monks Cross Park and Ride is extremely quick and easy, taking approximately **4 minutes.** Please see the map, or use our journey planner, to plan your route.

BY BUS

From York Railway Station, take bus number 9 to Monks Cross Park & Ride. From here, the stadium is 0.3 miles away.

From the city centre and surrounding areas, regular services run to the Monks Cross area.

BY TRAIN

The ticket office will open three hours prior to kick off and will close at half time. Please note for double header matches, the opening time will be three hours prior to the first kick off and closing time will be around half time of the second match.




